The solution extends standard Inventory Module capabilities and allows you to treat packaging as products, with or without an associated financial value. In this way, your packaging stock levels, movements, invoicing, purchase and disposal can all be tracked as an integrated part of your financial and logistics processes.

Simplify handling of standard packaging types

With DXC Shipping Packaging Management, you can define specific shipping, receiving, tracking and invoicing processes that are associated with handling of common packaging types such as returnable packaging, invoiceable packaging, disposable packaging and pool packaging.

The packaging composition (e.g., the number of items per box, boxes per cradle and cradles per pallet) can be defined in Packaging Groups, and these groups can be defined as a general set-up, per site, or for each combination of site and warehouse. The packaging composition can also be varied, for example, based on whether you are shipping to a domestic or international customer.

Define flexible packaging frameworks for customers and vendors

By defining packaging frameworks, you can see the balance of packaging for each customer or vendor and create invoices or credit notes based on the balance and location of returnable packaging. When you create a sales order or purchase order, the related packaging information is automatically included and the packaging quantities for that order are calculated and displayed.

Speed up processes with your shipping carriers

With DXC Shipping Packaging Management, you can set up site and warehouse information for shipping carriers and use a standard 'mode of delivery,' which combines details around the shipping carrier and the services they offer, to link it to the individual orders. When creating a sales order or purchase order, the shipping carrier's packaging setup is automatically transferred to the order based on the mode of delivery selected for the order and carrier in question.

Fast, reliable registration of shipments with mobile integration

You can use the solution with mobile (RF) devices to register details of the packaging type and quantity in both inbound and outbound shipments, based on a sales order or purchasing order, or by the customer, vendor or carrier reference number. You can also add additional notes such as the registration number of the delivery vehicle.
